Integration of Technology

DIGI-CLASSROOMS:

All pre- primary, primary, and middle wing classes have been converted into Digi- classrooms to enhance the teaching-learning process. Classrooms have been fitted with smart boards, and the teaching faculty uses innovative audio-visual content technology to empower students in their day-to-day teaching.

COMPUTER LAB:

The school has computer labs for students, with the latest hardware and software and high-speed internet.

OPEN GAMES AND SPORTS ARENAS:

Admission

Admissions are open for classes Nursery to Class VI at SXPS The school aspires to produce students who are outstanding in academics as well as social and ethical values, skills and attitudes to contribute positively to the society. Thus, the admission process is designed to test both aptitude and attitude. While the test assesses the proficiency in various subjects, it also reveals the child's problem-solving skills. Portions integrated in the admission process also examines the applicant's belief and value system on the basis of which he/she makes decisions and the way he/she handles and negotiates the external world. We believe that this method of testing the student will allow us to look at him/her holistically.



Registration

The Registration / Application Form should be filled accurately. A Registration Number will be generated after filling out the form. Parents are required to submit the hard copy of the Online Registration Form (duly filled-in printout) with a recent passport-size colour photograph of the candidate, their father and mother affixed on the Registration Form at the school office along with the Registration Fee in cash within three days of filling the Online Registration Form.

Parents are requested to carefully review the Admission Information on the school website before filling out the Registration Form. The applications will be scrutinized, and only those found complete in all respects will be selected for the Observation/Assessment Test. Intimation of the exact date and time, will be provided. Applying for registration/ admission does not imply Admission; Admission is subjected to Observation cum- Interaction/ Assessment. It is also subject to the availability of seats.

General rules Documents to be submitted at the time of admission:

1. **School leaving/transfer certificate and previous year's Report Card (without this, no student from Class II onwards will be admitted).**
2. **Medical Certificate in the given format.**
3. **The birth certificate, in its original form, is to be brought for verification only.**
4. **Recent passport-size colour photograph of the candidate and both the parents.**
5. **Admission will be cancelled if any variance is found between the particulars filled in the Registration Form and the documents submitted for admission.**
6. **A copy of the Aadhaar Card of the candidate**

⇒ **PAYMENT OF ADMISSION FEE TO BE MADE ONLINE AND CASH ONLY.**

⇒ **THE AMOUNT DEPOSITED TOWARDS REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION FOR A PARTICULAR YEAR IS NEITHER REFUNDABLE NOR TRANSFERABLE TO ANY OTHER YEAR. IF, FOR ANY REASON, A STUDENT WISHES TO WITHDRAW AFTER BEING ADMITTED TO THE SCHOOL, THE ADMISSION FEE DEPOSITED WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**

⇒ **THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR VARIOUS CLASSES IS BASED ON THE CHILD'S AGE.**

Admission Process

OBSERVATION-CUM-INTERACTION FOR CLASSES NURSERY, L.KG ,U.KG AND Grade I AND Grade II

Admission to Nursery, L.KG, U.KG, Grade I and Grade II will be granted based on the Observation-cum-Interaction. The presence of both parents during this period is mandatory.

ASSESSMENT AND INTERACTION SESSION FOR CLASS III ONWARDS

From Class III onwards, an assessment will be conducted, followed by an interactive session. Both parents must be in school on the designated day(s).

The parents must bring copies of the Admit Card on the date and time mentioned on the Admit Cards when they bring their ward(s) to School.

The entire procedure may last for three to four hours. Parents are advised to plan their schedules accordingly.

Before the commencement of the assessment, parents must hand over the student's copy of the Admit Card to the Session-In-Charge.



Age Criteria



The Age of Admission is 3 Years for Nursery and 4 Years for Junior K.G. 5, Years for Senior K.G., 6 Years for Std. 1 with Corresponding increased in the higher standards on or before 1st April.
